- Curriculum maybe expanded by including recent technology like IoT, Digital and sustainable Engineering.

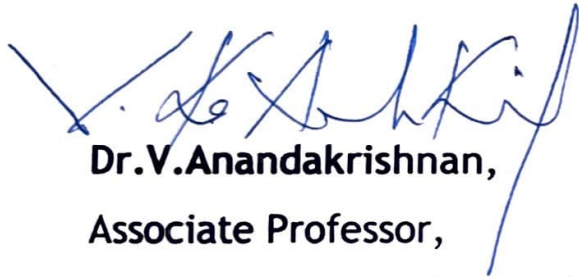
